- Maintain, stock, and clean Camp Store daily
- Process, account for, and manage cash transactions
- Assist the program team with activity preparation including decoration and props for major theme weeks including 4<sup>th</sup> July and Christmas in July
- Carry out tasks assigned by the Program/Camp Director
