Responsibilities

- Supervise the health and wellbeing of children ages 5-14
- Motivate, mentor and provide ongoing training to day camp staff
- Plan and oversee the implementation of a variety of camp activities, ensuring they're inclusive, engaging, age-appropriate and contribute to the overall social and spiritual development of campers
- Monitor expenses and ensure effective use of camp resources
- Work with staff to decorate areas befitting the theme of the week to a high standard
- Supervise and participate in all assigned aspects of the campers' day which includes but is not limited to: check-in, swim-time, chapel, meal-time, activities; and before/after-hours duties as assigned by the demands of the program or the camp director
- Provide evening coverage 2 nights p/w assist program instructors and counselors during activity periods as needed
