- Care for and supervise adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities for 6 days p/w

- Serve as a Christian role model to all those in your care
- Interpersonal skills - Build/maintain positive relationships with campers/staff
- Follow all camp policies and procedures
- Manage conflict between campers and re-direct challenging behaviors

Qualifications:

- 18 years or older, or high school graduate with 2-3 years of applicable experience
- Training is given but experience working with kids OR the disabilities population is essential
- Time management skills, proactivity/forthcoming with games and behavior redirection
- Good command of the English language both written and spoken
- Excellent communication, and interpersonal skills essential for community living
- Enthusiastic, resilient character with a selfless personality
- Public speaking skills - ability to lead group devotions centered on Christian beliefs
- First Aid/CPR certification desirable but not essential
- Ability to pass background check and provide 3x professional references
