Responsibilities:

- Plan and oversee the implementation of camp activities, ensuring they are inclusive, comprehensive and contribute to the overall social and spiritual development of campers.
- Supervise and manage counselors to ensure they provide appropriate levels of care, paying close attention to personal care and activities of daily living (ADLs), hygiene, dietary and behavior needs of campers and cleanliness of lodging
- Coordinate and work with camp nurse for medication passes
- Work with camp Director to act as point of contact between camp and caregiver
- Conduct daily debrief meetings with unit staff
- Redirect behaviors and de-escalate conflicts as needed
- Follow all camp policies and procedures and hold staff accountable to the same
- Cover one weekend holdover during the season

Qualifications:

- 21yrs or older pursuing career in OT, psychology, special ed, social work or nursing preferred
- 2-3 years applicable experience working with the IDD population
- 2-3 years' experience in a management role
- PCA or CNA certification desirable
- Good communication and interpersonal skills essential for community living
- Ability to work effectively as part of a team
- First Aid/CPR certification desirable but not essential
- Expresses an actively demonstrates a commitment to Christ - ability to lead bible studies and follow a Christian curriculum.
- Ability to pass background check and provide 3 positive references
