Responsibilities:

- Manage and lead waterfront staff roster lifeguards to ensure appropriate coverage
- Work to ensure a safe waterfront by conducting swim tests, Buddy Checks and facilitate rescue/emergency drills with waterfront staff
- Promote high levels of communication with program director and staff to ensure efficiency
- Help to develop and facilitate staff training, provide staff development opportunities and ongoing mentoring
- Facilitate all waterfront activities, and work with the program director to develop and evaluate the day-to-day operation of waterfront programs and activities
- Lead and/or participate in daily debriefs
- Report damage/repairs to the maintenance director ensure cleanliness of waterfront
- Assist with camper check-in/check-out process
- Supervise and assist in cleaning of boathouse and lifeguard shed
- Order, inventory, and monitor Lifeguard shed supplies (First Aid kits, wristbands) as well as cleaning supplies for Porta-Potty
- Work with leadership to ensure camp passes inspections and perform other duties as needed
- Assist program instructors and counselors during other activity periods as needed

- Physical ability and stamina to participate in all camp activities
- Enthusiasm, patience, meticulous organizational skills
- Desire to work with children and adults with disabilities in residential camp setting essential
- Fosters and actively demonstrates Christian values

Requirements

- At least 21 years of age with 2 years experience as a lifeguard
- Water Safety Instructor (WSI) certified with 2 years experience in a management role
- Ability to pass background checks and provide 3 positive references
- Good handle on the English language written and spoken
- First Aid/CPR certification required
